ELIGIBILITY

Eligible candidates must be graduates of Stark County High School in the Class of 2018. Scholarships may be used for tuition, books, or fees at the vocational school or program, community college, or university of the awardee's choice (or as specified by the award).

APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

1. **APPLICATION:** All applicants must submit a complete application that includes the Applicant and School Data Form, **proof of acceptance** to a post-secondary academic or vocational institution, and an essay.
2. **ESSAY:** All applicants must submit **a one page essay** that addresses the following questions:

What are your career plans, and how would scholarships help you achieve these goals?

(Formatting requirements: One typed page, double spaced, 12 point font, one inch margins on all sides. Essays that do not meet the formatting requirements will not be considered.)

3. **ADDITIONAL FORMS:** Some awards have their own application forms and additional criteria for eligibility. A student eligible for these awards must submit the appropriate forms and/or materials with their application packet. Students who are not eligible do not need to complete or include these forms.
4. **INTERVIEW:** In an informal interview with the selection committee, all applicants will answer the following questions:
 - A. *What person or event most influenced your future plans?*
 - B. *What values, habits, or personal attributes do you possess that will ensure your future success?*
 - C. *If you could do one thing in your years of schooling differently, what would that be?*
5. **NUMBER OF COPIES:** Once the application is complete, **make 4 copies of all pages.** (Single-sided copies only.)
6. **Submit the five complete packets** (the original and the four copies) to the High School Principal's Office by **4:00 PM on April 4.**

MARGARET K. POE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The Margaret K. Poe Memorial Scholarship fund was established in 2010 by Margaret K. Poe, a former Wyoming resident. The purpose of the award is to provide scholarships for secondary education for residents of the towns of Wyoming, Bradford, and Toulon.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Eligible candidates must satisfy all of the following criteria.
- Be a high school senior in the Stark County High School graduating class of 2018.
 - Show proof of acceptance as a full-time student in any college or junior college.
 - Be pursuing study in the fields of **medicine, nursing, or agriculture**.
 - Currently reside in the boundaries of the Bradford school district, the old Wyoming High School district, or the old Toulon-Lafayette school district.

THE AWARD:

Three scholarships of \$21,500 each will be awarded. One will be awarded to a 2018 graduate residing in the Bradford school district. One will be awarded to a 2018 graduate residing in the old Wyoming High School district. And, one will be awarded to a 2018 graduate residing in the old Toulon-Lafayette school district.

Scholarships will be paid in equal installments over a maximum of four years as long as the award winner remains eligible. Funds may be used for tuition, room and board, textbooks, or other educational costs.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

1. Application Form--Applicants must submit a complete application form.
2. Proof of Acceptance—Applicants must submit proof of acceptance into a college or university in the fields of **medicine, nursing, or agriculture**.
3. Essay—Applicants must submit a one page essay that addresses the following questions:
What are your career plans, and how would this scholarship help you achieve these goals?
(Formatting requirements: One typed page, double spaced, 12 point font, one inch margins on all sides.)
4. Interview: Applicants will attend a 15 minute interview with the scholarship committee.
